## SUPPLEMENT TO PROTECTIVE COVENANTS

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS that the undersigned, Roger L. Mowen, being the owner of the real estate described in the Protective Covenants dated the 12th day of December, 1996, and recorded in Book 92 of Miscellaneous Records, at page 317 in the Office of the Recorder of Deeds in and for Adams County, Illinois, which said real estate has been subdivided and is now known as White Oak Estates and consists of Lots One (1), Two (2), Three (3), Four (4), Five (5), Six (6), Seven (7), and Eight (8) hereby makes and establishes the following Protective Covenants in addition to those contained in the Protective Covenants dated December 12, 1996, and recorded as aforesaid, and the Protective Covenants described herein shall have priority over the Protective Covenants dated December 12, 1996:

This Supplement to Protective Covenants shall run with the land and shall be binding upon the present Owners of the Real Estate and shall be binding upon each and every person, firm and/or corporation claiming by, through or under them, as if this Amendment was part of the original Protective Covenants. All words and phrases having a defined meaning when used in the Protective Covenants shall have the same meaning when used herein.

These covenants shall take effect upon the recording hereof and shall apply to all of the above described real estate and to each lot thereof.

- 1. Each residential lot shall contain no out buildings other than one lawn storage building which shall contain no more than 250 square feet.
