

## NOTICE TO ELDERLY (OVER 65) AND VOTERS WITH A DISABILITY REGARDING THE GENERAL ELECTION TO BE HELD ON NOVEMBER 3<sup>RD</sup>, 2020



Notice is hereby given to elderly (over 65) and voters with a disability that the Adams County Election Office has complied with Federal and State Election Laws to promote the fundamental right to vote by improving access to Registration, Polling Places, and Election Day voting as follows:

If you are elderly (over 65) or a voter with a disability (and are unable to come to the Courthouse) and need to be registered or need to transfer your registration, please call the Adams County Clerk's Office (217-277-2150) and they will mail a registration form to you.

Any person who is unable to go to the Polling Place to vote may call the Adams County Clerk's Office (277-2150) for an alternative means of casting your vote.

Voting aids are available for the elderly and disabled including a voter assist unit, assistance in marking the ballot, and vision magnifiers.

Applications for vote-by-mail ballots may be obtained by calling the County Clerk's Office (217-277-2150). Early voting will be held in the Office of the County Clerk, 507 Vermont St., Quincy, IL beginning September 24<sup>th</sup>, 2020 and concluding Monday, November 2<sup>nd</sup>, 2020 from the hours of 8:30 A.M. until 4:30 P.M. Monday thru Friday, except holidays. Visit the County Clerk's website or call the office for extended hours and Saturday Early Voting hours.
