<u>Sheriff Dept – Report from Sheriff Wagner</u>

- The current jail population is 112 males and 11 females for a total of 123.
- There are currently two officers out on COVID quarantine.
- Thomas McKenna and Kelsey Soebing have been hired as Court Security Officers.

Emergency Management – John Simon

- They are wrapping up day two of COVID vaccinations at the Oakley-Lindsay Center.
- They gave 800 doses on day 1 and another 1,100 on day 2.
- They have 5,000 doses of vaccine to give this week and have all the slots filled by patients aged 65 and older.
- People who receive vaccine will automatically be scheduled for their second dose three to four weeks later at the same time. If a person will be unable to be present for the second dose they should not schedule the first dose.
- Adams County has received more vaccine per capita than any other county in Illinois.
- They are testing about 400 people per day at the OLC.
- With the move to Phase IV Mitigation, things are opening back up.
- They have hired more than 40 temporary workers to do vaccinations. These people are being paid with FEMA, CURES and various other COVID response funds.

Coroner — No Report

The Coroner's case count has doubled since November.
