Public Health & Safety

Committee Report (Mrs. Fletcher)

<u>Bills</u> – The committee met on April 20, 2021 and reviewed the bills for the Sheriff's Office, Coroner's Office, Emergency Management Agency and Animal Control. All of the bills were in order.

Reports-

Mr. Peter read the following reports from department heads and/or their representatives: From Sheriff Wagner: The Jail Administrator, Chad Downs, is stepping down, having accepted a position in court security. The jail population was at 121. 9 IDOC inmates were transferred on April 19. There are 6 more inmates ready for transfer. There were no known employees or inmates with COVID-19. The department is in the process of reviewing the jail medical contract with QMG. The contract has been proofread by the States Attorney and is awaiting signature by QMG. The department has been conducting interviews for the vacant administrative assistant position.

From the Coroner, Scott Graham: There were 83 reported deaths, 6 autopsies, 1 abandoned cremation and 34 cremation permits issued in March 2021. He reported there have been no suicides this year.

From John Simon, Emergency Management/Ambulance: The department is inspecting the four new ambulance units. There are 3 box and 1 van style vehicles. They expect to have them in rotation within 45 days. COVID testing and vaccination is winding down and they will soon close down the Oakley-Lindsay facility and move operations to the health department. Approximately 60% of the 65 and over population of the county is vaccinated. That percentage has risen since the time of the committee meeting. COVID vaccination efforts are expanding to outreach clinics and pharmacies and into the villages throughout the county.

Mr. Kerkhoff asked if appointments were still needed to get a vaccine.

Mr. Austin stated you can make an appointment at the Health Department, but the remote ones do not require an appointment. Mr. Duesterhaus asked if they lowered the age limit yet. Mr. Austin stated that would happen in two weeks.

The committee's next meeting is scheduled for Tuesday, May 18, 2021 at 6:30 PM.

Ladies and Gentlemen:

Your Committee, with the approval of the Illinois Department of Transportation, advertised for bids and held a letting on April 27, 2021 for 200,000 gallons of various liquid bituminous asphalt materials (furnished); 3,860 feet of various size metal pipe culverts, (delivered); 51,000 gallons of Lignin LS-50 (applied in solution); approximately 35,000 gallons of PG52-28 liquid bituminous asphalt materials, (applied); and 1,400 tons of various seal coat aggregates, (applied); required in the maintenance of Road District Roads with Road District Motor Fuel Tax Funds.

Illinois Valley Paving, Winchester, IL, was the low bidder on the liquid bituminous asphalt materials (furnished), Group 117, with a total bid of \$580,000.00. The unsuccessful bidder was the W.L. Miller Company, Hamilton, IL, with a total bid of \$592,640.00.

Contech Engineered Solutions, Springfield, IL, was the low bidder on the aluminized & poly coated steel pipe culverts and the corrugated structural steel plate pipe arches (delivered), Groups 118 through 131, with a total bid of \$224,085.52. The unsuccessful bidder was Metal Culverts Inc., Jefferson City, MO, with a total bid of \$283,595.00.

Environmental Road Solutions, Roseville, IL, was the low bidder on the Lignin LS-50 (applied in solution), Groups 132 through 136, with a total bid of \$33,150.00. The unsuccessful bidder was Buss Ag Services LLC, Mendon, IL, with a total bid of \$33,660.00.

Diamond Construction Company, Quincy, Illinois; was the only bidder on the liquid bituminous asphalt materials and seal coat aggregate (applied), Group 137, with a total bid of \$189,576.25.

Your Committee, after carefully considering these bids, and with the consent of the Illinois Department of Transportation, awarded contracts to Illinois Valley Paving, Contech Engineered Solutions, Environmental Road Solutions and Diamond Construction Co. on their respective low bids.

Your Committee asks that its action in awarding these contracts be concurred upon by this Board.

RESOLUTION NO. 2021-05-001-010

A RESOLUTION CALLING FOR THE GOVERNOR AND GENERAL ASSEMBLY TO PROTECT LOCAL CONTROL OF ZONING AND LAND USE

WHEREAS, Counties are authorized by the Counties Code (55 ILCS 5/1-1001 et seq.) to adopt and develop zoning regulations; and

WHEREAS, Section 5-12001 of the Counties Code provides "the county board or board of county commissioners, as the case may be, of each county, shall have the power to regulate and restrict the location and use of buildings, structures and land" and "to regulate and restrict the intensity of such uses, to establish building or setback lines on or along any street, trafficway, drive, parkway or storm or floodwater runoff channel or basin outside the limits of cities, villages and incorporated towns which have in effect municipal zoning ordinances" (55 ILCS 5/5-12001); and

WHEREAS, consistent with their zoning authority, numerous Counties throughout the state of Illinois have adopted zoning and setback regulations related to wind energy facilities such as the model ordinance prepared by the Chicago Environmental Law Clinic and have made substantial revisions over time to suit the needs of their Counties and the residents of their Counties; and

WHEREAS, Senate Bill 1602 was filed in the Illinois Senate on February 26, 2021 and seeks to mandate very specific timelines and procedural requirements regarding siting approval or a special use permits for commercial wind energy facilities; and

WHEREAS, Senate Bill 1602 also mandates substantive changes including setback requirements, blade tip height limitations, and sound limitations; and

WHEREAS, Senate Bill 1602 requires that any currently-existing county zoning ordinances pertaining to wind farms be amended within 120 days to comply with the requirements of the bill and prohibits a county from adopting any future restrictions on the installation or use of a commercial wind energy facility that are inconsistent with the provisions of the bill; and

WHEREAS, the changes contained in Senate Bill 1602 ignore differences that occur locally from county to county across the State of Illinois and remove a county board's ability to regulate those local differences and address the concerns of their residents; and

WHEREAS, Senate Bill 1602 further undermines local control in that it substitutes state level legislative determination for the local control exercised by county zoning commissions, zoning boards of appeals, and county boards; and

WHEREAS, the County Board is the best entity to support the needs, interests, and safety of its residents due to direct feedback and understanding of the County's needs, while State officials or industry leaders who do not reside in these Counties may not be aware of the most relevant and current information.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the members of the Board of Adams County, Illinois as follows:







WHAT IS A "HAZARD TREE?"

Ameren Illinois employs vegetation management techniques which are designed to promote tree health and protect our electric delivery system. Part of our vegetation management plan includes working with municipalities to identify hazard trees which are candidates for removal. A hazard tree is a dead, dying or otherwise unstable tree that is threatening the power lines and must be addressed on a case-by-case basis. This includes trees that are well below the power lines, yet could cause future interference as they grow. If trimmed away from the power lines, these trees will still need continual maintenance trimming every few years. These trees are targets for removal.

VEGETATION MANAGEMENT BASICS

- Trees growing up toward the power lines are targets for removal. Even trees that are well below the power lines should be removed to prevent future interference. Stumps will not be ground out.
- We will coordinate tree removal with the city.
- 3. City is responsible for removal of debris.


GRANT PROGRAM BASICS

- Only trees growing in public rights-of-way and having the potential to interfere with overhead lines are eligible for the grant program.
- Trees must be identified before removal and approved as eligible by your local Ameren Illinois Forestry Supervisor.
- 3. \$125 will be awarded for each eligible tree removed, up to \$2,500.
- 4. Communities may use the funds in a manner consistent with the Right Tree, Right Place principles. Some examples include:
 - » Planting new trees outside of the right-of-way
 - Planting approved replacement trees inside the right of way (work with your Ameren Illinois Forestry Supervisor)
 - » Developing a community-wide tree management plan
 - » Maintenance of existing trees
 - » Obtaining Tree City USA certification
- Communities may apply more than once per year, but the maximum annual grant award will be \$2,500.
- Only government entities (villages, towns, townships, and counties) are eligible to apply.
- 7. Community members must receive electric delivery service from Ameren Illinois.

Prince Minerals, LLC has requested that the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency (Illinois EPA) renew the Clean Air Act Permit Program (CAAPP) permit regulating air emissions from its facility located at 401 North Prince Plaza in Quincy. The source produces various coarse mineral products. The significant operations at the source include material bagging, storage, conveying, crushing, drying, calcining, loading, milling and screening. Based on its review of the application, the Illinois EPA has made a preliminary determination that the application meets the standards for issuance and has prepared a draft permit for public review.

The Illinois EPA is accepting comments on the draft permit. Comments must be received by 11:59 PM on April 23, 2021. If sufficient interest is expressed in the draft permit, a hearing or other informational meeting may be held. Copies of the draft permit and other documents may also be available at http://bit.ly/2SiUSql. Copies of the documents will be made available upon request.

The CAAPP is Illinois' operating permit program for major sources of emissions, as required by Title V of the Clean Air Act (Act). The conditions of CAAPP permits are enforceable by the public, as well as by the USEPA and Illinois EPA. In addition to implementing Title V of the Act, CAAPP permits may contain "Title I Conditions," i.e., conditions established under the permit programs for new and modified emission units, pursuant to Title I of the Act.

The facility is located in an area of Environmental Justice concern. More information concerning Environmental Justice may be found at https://www2.illinois.gov/epa/topics/environmental-justice/Pages/default.aspx.

The beginning of this public comment period also serves as the beginning date of the USEPA 45 day review period, provided the USEPA does not seek a separate proposed period.
