The committee reviewed the minutes from the previous meeting. Raquel Piazza moved to approve them as written, seconded by Marvin Kerkhoff. Theresa Bockhold had two spelling corrections to the minutes. The minutes were adopted as amended unanimously.

Mrs. Bockhold read a re-appointment to the Golden Fire Protection District for Richard Flesner for a three-year term. A motion was made to approve the re-appointment by Raquel Piazza and seconded by Marvin Kerkhoff. The committee approved the re-appointment unanimously.

Mrs. Bockhold presented a special one-day liquor permit for the Adams County Fair Association's County Fair to be held on July 28, 2021 through August 3, 2021 at the Fairgrounds. Mrs. Piazza moved to approve the permit, seconded by Mr. Kerkhoff. The committee approved the permit.

Mrs. Bockhold presented a special one-day liquor permit for the Mustang Football Booster Club's Annunal Spring Dinner & Auction to be held on June 26, 2021. Mrs. Piazza moved to approve the permit, seconded by Mr. Kerkhoff. The committee approved the permit.

Mrs. Bockhold presented Resolution Number 2021-05-001-010 titled the Protect Local Control of Land Use of Wind Farms. Mr. Niekamp advised the committee that, if passed, the resolution would inform our state representatives, and governor, that Adams County stands behind local control of land use. Mr. Niekamp further stated that if the state adopted the bill, it would then take the wind farm control out of local hands and place the process back on the state for approval, or denial, without much insight from the local boards – this would run much like the hog confinement hearings / process. The committee did not have much comment regarding this resolution. Mrs. Bockhold moved to send it to the Board, seconded by Ms. Piazza. The committee approved to send the entire resolution to the full board for adoption.
