Transportation, Building & Technology

Committee Report (Mr. Bellis)

Mr. Peter explained that this is doing the same thing we did last year and has worked well in the past. Mr. Hinkamper asked how long this is going to keep being passed as temporary. Mr. Niekamp stated that the IL Veterans Home is under construction and we cannot use it. He also stated the Health Department recommends to stay out of the nursing homes. Mr. Demoss asked if his office has looked at the St. Johns Church School. Mr. Hinkamper stated that the church is only a block away from the current locations. Mr. Niekamp stated that his office would take a look at that church.

Mr. Todd Eyler explained that this is in response to a House Bill with an attempt to address high quality low-income housing in Illinois. This bill was focused to Cook County. He stated it changes nothing currently and is just an opt-out clause that we have the ability to do as a county. He stated that if we did not opt-out, it would add an entire new program that would put a lot of extra work on the Assessor's Office. He stated our Assessor's office does not have the resources to implement this program. He explained that we can opt-in later on at any time. He stated this is not a statement that the board does not support low-income housing or anything like that. This resolution just takes a position that property owners cannot come get a reduction of their property taxes because they rent to low-income people.

The resolution was approved.

He stated this would be from Hampshire St to Broadway St. He stated Ameren is putting in \$700,000, we got a grant through the state for \$350,000, the City is putting

in \$350,000 and our portion would be for an amount up to \$200,000. Our portion could be less than that depending on what the project comes to.

Resolution for Improvement by County Under the Illinois Highway Code

By Transportation, Building & Technology Committee

TO THE HONORABLE COUNTY BOARD

Gentlemen:

WHEREAS, the County of Adams, Illinois is proposing to improve County Highway 11, beginning at a point approximately 220 feet North of SN 001-3303 (South Fork of Bear Creek bridge) and extending northerly to the south edge of pavement of IL 61/94, for a distance of 2.63 miles. The type of improvement to be milling and resurfacing of East 2300th Street (CH 11) (FAS Route 1589) with 1¼" HMA Binder Course and 1½" HMA Surface Course, along with incidental HMA, aggregate shoulders, pavement markings and other ancillary work. The improvement shall be designated Section 16-00017-05-FP, Job No. C-96-053-21 and Project No. VA5R(542).

WHEREAS, the above stated improvement will necessitate the use of funding provided through the Illinois Department of Transportation (IDOT); and signee

WHEREAS, the use of these funds requires a joint funding agreement (AGREEMENT) with IDOT; and

WHEREAS, the improvement requires matching funds; and

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Adams County Board:

Section 1: The Adams County Board hereby appropriates One Hundred Eighty Thousand dollars (\$180,000.00) or as much as may be needed to match the required funding to complete the proposed improvement for the County Matching Tax Fund and furthermore agree to pass a supplemental resolution if necessary to appropriate additional funds for the completion of the project.

Section 2: The Chairman of the Adams County Board is hereby authorized to execute an AGREEMENT with IDOT for the above-mentioned project.

Section 3: This resolution will become Attachment 3 of the AGREEMENT.

Section 4: The Count Clerk of Adams County is directed to transmit three (3) copies of the AGREEMENT and Resolution to IDOT District 6 Bureau of Local Roads and Streets.

RESOLUTION TO OPT-OUT OF PREFERENTIAL ASSESSMENT FOR RENTAL HOUSING CONSTRUCTION AND REHABILITATION PURSUANT TO PROPERTY TAX CODE, 35 ILCS 200/15-178

TO THE HONORABLE ADAMS COUNTY BOARD

WHEREAS, the Illinois General Assembly passed Public Act 102-0175, which amended the Property Tax Code (35 ILCS 200/15-178) by providing for a preferential assessment for low-income housing; and

WHEREAS, this preferential assessment is designed for property in Cook County, but is applicable to all counties within Illinois; and

WHEREAS, the reduction of taxable value for one property results in a corresponding increase in property taxes for all other taxpayers in a jurisdiction; and

WHEREAS, the Supervisor of Assessments does not currently have the personnel, equipment, or office space to administer such a program, and has advised that the implementation of such a program in Adams County would require significant financial resources to administer; and

WHEREAS, the Property Tax Code, 35 ILCS 200/15-178 (b) provides that: “Any county with less than 3,000,000 inhabitants may decide not to implement one or both of the special assessment programs defined in subparagraph (1) of subsection (c) of this Section and subparagraph (2) of subsection (c) of this Section upon passage of an ordinance by a majority vote of the county board”; and

WHEREAS, the Property Tax Code, 35 ILCS 200/15-178 (b) further provides that “Subsequent to a vote to opt out of this special assessment program, any county with less than 3,000,000 inhabitants may decide to implement one or both of the special assessment programs defined in subparagraph (1) of subsection (c) of this Section and subparagraph (2) of subsection (c) of this Section upon passage of an ordinance by a majority vote of the county board; and

WHEREAS, Adams County, Illinois has less than 3,000,000 inhabitants; and

WHEREAS, the County Board of Adams County finds it is in the best interests of the citizens of Adams County to opt-out of the special assessment programs and the provisions of 35 ILCS 200/15-178.



The first priority project identified in the Riverfront Master Plan is the burial of the Ameren overhead power lines along the riverfront from Jersey Street to the Quincy Boat Club. This will allow for other planned projects in Clat Adams Park and eliminate an eyesore to the appearance of the riverfront, potentially resulting in more foot traffic and additional development in the future.

The city of Quincy and Ameren Illinois are working together on this public/private partnership. Ameren intends to invest up to \$700,000 to install the electrical lines underground, to reconnect the Front Street electrical grid and to remove the overhead electrical towers. The city has spent \$53,000 on engineering, construction easements and platting to put the project out for bid. The city, through the efforts of State Sen. Jil Tracy, has also secured a \$350,000 Illinois Capital Grant to help pay for the purchase and burial of the ducts that will house the electrical lines.

The city initially estimated the \$350,000 grant would cover Phase I of the project (Hampshire Street to the Quincy Boat Club). But with prevailing wage and the increased cost of building materials, the city's Engineering Department now estimates the cost could be closer to \$500,000.

I am asking you and the Adams County Board to consider investing \$200,000 towards the Riverfront Power Line Burial Project to help cover this project.

Please let me know if you need additional information on the project.

RESOLUTION NO. 2022-04-311-015

RESOLUTION TO SUPPORT UNEMPLOYED ESSENTIAL WORKPLACE SKILLS THROUGH ADAMS COUNTY EMPOWERED (A.C.E)

WHEREAS, The American Rescue Plan Act provides for State And Local Fiscal Recovery Funds, a definition which includes Adams County, Illinois and authorizes \$12,709,982 in total funds for Adams County, the first half of which has been received and is under deposit, and

WHEREAS, many individuals lost employment or were unable to obtain employment due to the COVID-19 pandemic and/or resulting recession; and

WHEREAS, the Adams County Probation Department has developed the Adams County Empowered (“ACE”) Program, designed to target the underserved population of individuals presently on probation, and provide them with workplace skills and training essential to secure employment; and

WHEREAS, the American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA), 42 U.S.C. 802 *et seq.*, established the Coronavirus Local Fiscal Recovery Fund giving local governments resources to respond to the impacts of COVID-19, eligible uses of which include assisting unemployed workers with job training for employment, both those who became unemployed due to the COVID-19 pandemic or were already unemployed and remained so due to its negative economic impacts; and

WHEREAS, the Treasury Department’s Interim Final Rule, 31 C.F.R. Part 35, gives additional guidance on eligible uses of these funds, which include services like job training for unemployed workers to accelerate their hiring.


NOW THEREFORE, the Adams County Board hereby ordains the following:

1. The Adams County Board authorizes the use of \$50,000.00 of the current balance of American Rescue Plan Act, State And Local Fiscal Recovery funds to establish and operate the Adams County Empowered (“ACE”) Program; and
2. The Adams County Board has assigned clear responsibilities for periodic reporting of progress on this project to the Adams County Board or its designated agent, Bellwether LLC.

Passed by the Board of Adams County this 13 day of April, 2022.



The Administrative Office of the Illinois Courts (AOIC) has approved Adams County Probation Department's County Fiscal Year 2022 Annual Probation Plan. The approved County Fiscal Year 2022 budget has been received. The continued usage of probation fees for client services is commendable though it is noted some expenditures are allocated for operations. Please note the use of fees for this purpose does not fall within the statutory provision as provided by 730 ILCS 110/12(11) which reads in part, "The respective counties shall be responsible for the capital and space costs, fringe benefits, clerical costs, equipment, telecommunications, postage, commodities, and printing" or Administrative Office's *Probation Policies and Guidelines (March 1, 2012)*, pages 1-15. After an additional review of the Salary Shortfall worksheet was conducted, it was determined that actual salary shortfall amount is \$24,319.02. The request to use this money from the Probation Fees Fund to cover shortfall is approved.

It is noted that the Adam County's Compensation Schedule is increased by 2.25% along with a salary increase of 2.25% for staff and management. Due to changes population sizes, the request to convert GIA positions 2400 juvenile probation officer and 1200 problem solving court officer to an adult/juvenile probation line officer position is approved. Approval for the other request to add two full time juvenile detention line officer positions been deferred until further analysis of state resources and operational need is completed.

The department's dedication toward ensuring staff have completed the training hours required by Administrative Office standards commendable. Once the Supreme Court of Illinois Judicial College's course catalog for probation and court services is released later this year, it will provide approved training for the completion of the required hours. This will ensure officers across the state continue to meet training expectations.


The updated policies and procedures for Adult Interstate Compact has been reviewed and are consistent with the Interstate Compact standards. We also acknowledge that probation department will continue the implementation of the Casework Standards and complete Core Correctional Practice training with all staff. Along with the probation departments goals, the juvenile detention facility will continue to work on becoming PREA (Prison Rape Elimination Act) compliant. Please contact our office if assistance is needed.

As always, the Annual Probation Plan approval is based upon a department's continued compliance with the provisions of the Probation and Probation Officers Act (730 ILCS 110), and with applicable administrative, operational, and program standards and guidelines established by the Administrative Office of the Illinois Courts. We look forward to working with your department in the upcoming year especially in the continued application of evidence-based practices to probation and court services.




