TO OBTAIN A COPY OF A MARRIAGE RECORD:

- 1) Complete this application.
- 2) Your application must be signed by you.
- 3) You must be one of the following:
 - -One of the spouses on the certificate
 - -A parent named on certificate
- 4) Include a copy of your identification (see below for acceptable forms of identification).
- 5) Include your payment (see below for acceptable forms of payment).

FEES:

- -Include a check, cashier's check or money order for payment made out to "Adams County Clerk".
- -One copy is \$25.00.
- -Each additional certified copy of the same record issued at the same time is \$15.00.

IN PERSON: Visit the Office of the Adams County Clerk at 507 Vermont St. in Quincy, IL. (Located in the West/5th Street Entrance) Methods of Payment: Cash, check or credit/debit card. There is an additional fee for using a card for payment.

BY MAIL: Complete form, make copy of acceptable identification (and any necessary documentation), and make payment in form of personal check, cashier's check or money order payable to "Adams County Clerk". Send to Office of the Adams County Clerk, 507 Vermont St. Quincy, IL 62301.

ACCEPTABLE FORMS OF IDENTIFICATION:

One of the following:

-Driver's License/State ID Card -U.S. Passport - Consulate ID Card -US Military ID Card -US Naturalization Certificate -US Immigration Card

-OR-

One of the following as well as a piece of recently post-marked mail:

-Medical or Car Insurance Card -Bank Statement (90 Days) -Credit Card Statement -Public Assistance Card -Paycheck Stub -W-2 Form (Most Current) -Voter's Registration Card -Vehicle Registration -School Photo ID -Utility Bill (60 Days) -Checkbook with Name and Address -Work Photo ID Card
